
Forthcoming events at the Centre

creative ways to grow and learn together in the love of God.


The day will cover all the sessions, giving us plenty to take away and think about.

Join us as we use the Archbishop's Lent book 'Embracing Justice' to find ways to practice justice in our churches and communities.


Six weekly afternoon sessions starting at 2pm: March 7th 14th, 21st, 28th, April 4th and 11th
