Doubt is a very human condition, which can lead us to God through questioning, honing our faith rather than standing against it.

The day will focus on:


The Passion in Black and White: Rembrandt's Etchings

# Walking with Jesus Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March, 9.30 for 10am till 3pm




Led by Rev Jane Winter, our walk falls on the eve of St Patrick's Day.

Silence is one of the cornerstones of the Benedictine tradition.


The Rule of St. Benedict tells us:

#### A Quiet Day led by members of the Prayer Book Society


